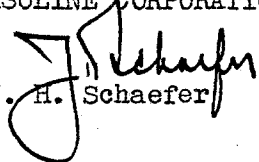

Dr. Machle has examined the four ETHYL Tank Truck Operators and has found no indication of trouble.

From their history, Dr. Machle has therefore advised us that the Medical Department does not feel that it will be necessary to continue the examination of your drivers except in case there should be an accident or any incident in which there was a definite exposure. In such cases, they shall then be required to report to us at which time arrangements will be made for a special examination at the duPont Dye Works Hospital. Will you, therefore, please instruct your men accordingly?

With the discontinuance of the examination requirement, I am sure this will give you more flexibility in your selection of drivers from time to time.
