SCARLET LAKE A:

We are sending you under separate cover sample of Crimson Lake B which G. Siegle Co. submit against Scarlet Lake A. They offer this material at \$1.40 per lb. fob New York.

According to test made in this office, this is no match whatever for the old Scarlet Lake A and for a substitute we believe price would be prohibitive, having purchased a closer match in the past from J.S. & W.R. Eakins at a much lower price. We are sending sample however for your information.

FACTORY COLORS:

Referring to your private letter of the 3rd inst., Mr. Somers of Fred. L. Lavenburg Co. advises there have been no further changes in prices of dry colors, and as far as he can tell conditions point to a steady market for a while at least.
