

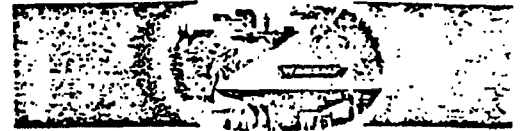

REPORT SUMMARY

"The employee health services were reviewed and the following suggestions offered for consideration:

1. Medical Direction

- a. Invite the 'on call' servicing physician to make periodic plant visits. *T. Baker*
1. To become acquainted with the plant environment and operations.
2. To give sound advice regarding scope of program and preventive health and safety measures.

2. Record System

- ✓ a. Maintain all pertinent health information on each employee in individual folders in employee health unit locked file.
- ✓ b. Update physical examination form.

- ✓ c. Incorporate procedures and policies into an employee health procedure manual to insure standard and continuity of service. *Modified*

1. Develop and include nurse's job description.

3. Health

a. Health maintenance program.

- ✓ 1. Health histories to be taken by nurse.
2. Physical examination findings to be interpreted as to work ability by the physician to assist management in proper placement. Develop a code for this purpose to be used by personnel department in placement. ←
3. In long-range planning, develop a periodic physical examination program to include all employees.
4. For those employees working with asbestos, consider having chest X-ray and physical examination findings reviewed by Employers Mutuals of Wausau consultant, O. A. Sander, M.D., an authority in the field of chest conditions. ←
- ✓ 5. Purchase a Snellen eye chart for vision screening.

4. Health Education

- ✓ a. Develop a follow-up file for employees with known disabilities and chronic health conditions for planned counseling. *Modified*

5. Preparation for Mass In-Plant Emergencies

- a. Offer a basic first-aid course to be given by American Red Cross at the plant to foremen.
- b. Prepare an alternate for Mrs. Elliott, R.N., in the event of her absence.

"It was suggested that a toxicology chart be developed on all hazardous materials used in plant. This to include:

1. Hazard
2. Operation involved
3. Mode of entry
