Frequency - Tetra Ethyl Lead Examinations

We recently discussed changing the frequency of the Tetra Ethyl Lead examinations from once each three weeks to once each four weeks. This will facilitate the ease with which the examination may be performed since the Tetra Ethyl Lead area is now working four shifts and since the individuals will rotate on the day shift once each four weeks.
