Health Safety Warning for UNIBESTOS Cartons

July 24, 1968

Gentlemen:

As you know, all members of NIMA are printing their cartons for calcium silicate (and other materials containing asbestos fibers) with the following warning outlined in red:

"THIS PRODUCT CONTAINS ASBESTOS FIBER. IF DUST IS
CREATED WHEN THIS PRODUCT IS HANDLED, AVOID BREATHING
THE DUST. IF ADEQUATE VENTILATION IS NOT POSSIBLE,
WEAR RESPIRATOR APPROVED BY U.S. BUREAU OF MINES."

George Duncan, attorney in the Tomplait Case, has recommended to Dick Packard that PC commence using such a legend on our cartons "as soon as it is feasible to do so." He states that all other defendants already are doing so.

I would like to suggest that we discuss this situation further as soon as practical.
