. . . we took a different view, reporting that one libertarian observer suggests that the Trump administration's "red team, blue team" approach to refine climate science could create an "opportunity" to shift Republicans' view of the science, despite sharp criticism of the idea from environmentalists and scientists.

In Paris news, a new Congressional Research Service report finds possible fiscal savings from President Donald Trump's decision to withdraw the United States from the Paris climate agreement but potential negative impacts on domestic businesses that export clean technology to developing countries.

Speaking of Congress, Maine's two senators are re-introducing legislation that would expand tax credits for renewables to include biomass-generated power, with the effort winning early praise from a biomass industry group.

And our daily news roundup looked at recent remarks from former President Barack Obama bemoaning his successor's lack of "leadership" on climate change.
