Enclosed are a number of bulletins concerning the toxicity and safe handling of our Pydraul hydraulic fluids. Included specifically are a bulletin describing Pydraul F-9 and a copy of the report from Kettering Laboratories indicating their studies with this fluid. Although the figures and tables have been somewhat emasculated, I believe you will find the results indicated in the discussion. Please return this to me when you have had a chance to review it. 10-7-64

The booklet on Pydraul AC includes a typed discussion of the animal toxicity studies. Accompanying the Pydraul A-200 bulletin there is a Xeroxed sheet summarizing animal toxicity studies with this product.

There are enclosed also two reprints concerning chronic vapor inhalation studies with Aroclors 1242 and 1254. These you may keep also. You will recall that I told you on the telephone our Therminol series FR-1, FR-2, FR-3 are specially refined Aroclors. Thus, FR-1 is Aroclor 1242 (48% chlorinated diphenyl), FR-2 is Aroclor 1248 (48% chlorinated diphenyl) and FR-3 is Aroclor 1254 (54% chlorinated diphenyl).
