During the recent examinations at your laboratory I found that Mr. [REDACTED] exhibited some signs and symptoms which might have been referable to lead absorption. We find, however, that analysis of the excreta and blood examinations makes this highly improbable, and we feel that the symptoms are in all probability due to other causes, the possibility of which I discussed with Mr. [REDACTED] at the time of examination. Therefore, we feel that it is altogether safe for Mr. [REDACTED] to continue at his present work.
