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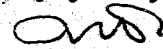
Dear Bob:

By way of introduction to my subject, please note the enclosed copy of a January 24 letter from Mr. F. B. Elder.

We have undertaken to be responsible for the preparation of a Monograph on Lead to be published by the American Chemical Society, a volume which may run to something like 1,000 pages. A section on the hazards to health inherent in the handling and use of lead and lead products will have a place in this opus and it has occurred to me that all or part of the forthcoming revision of the APHA manual, with APHA consent and proper credit, might be used for this.

I shall take this up with Mr. Elder when he returns from a current absence, but in the meantime I would welcome word from you on (a) what you think of the idea, and (b) what the chances are of the manual's availability by the deadline against which we are working, January 1, 1958.
