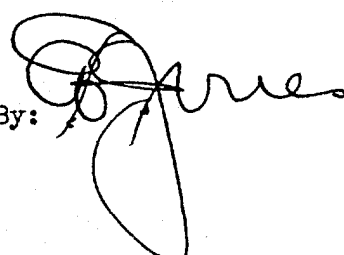
As suggested in your letter, we will write Dr. Edelman to the effect that this matter can be handled satisfactorily, sending you a copy for your file.

We are not entirely clear as to the periodicity of orders which might be expected. In your report you state that they wish to manufacture approximately 450 lbs. of ethyl arsenious dichloride over a period of about 30 days. Was it your understanding that this was to be one batch or to be repeated at intervals in the future?
