I propose the following arrangement of the words

FOR USE AS A
MOTOR FUEL ONLY
CONTAINS
L E A D
ANTIKNOCK COMPOUNDS

In order to be sure that there is no hitch or misunderstanding in connection with this wording and arrangement, I would like to have a message from each of you confirming your satisfaction or giving me your views of it otherwise. While I have no reason to doubt that this will meet general approval, I am taking a little extra time to be doubly certain in this case, after which I shall write to Dr. Price of the Public Health Service, merely stating the case.
