2 disease of asbestosis?

3 A Of course. They had no substitute. They  
4 had to have something to insulate high temperature  
5 pipes.

6 BY MR. SMITH:

7 Q You agreed with that, but my question was,  
8 do you agree that you had known since the 1940s that  
9 the asbestos workers who were using the asbestos  
10 pipecovering materials were at risk of getting  
11 asbestosis?

12 A No, you mean what would I have done about  
13 it?

14 Q Not what you would have done. You had known  
15 that that risk existed?

16 A Yeah, I think so.

17 Q And that was one that you knew during the  
18 time that you were an assistant to the president of  
19 Owens-Corning when you were at Toledo, correct?

20 A Right.

21 Q And that knowledge then, is consistent with
