In a recent safety meeting attended by our Mr. A. H. Chenault, for the Standard Oil Company of California, Mr. D. Harger, Assistant Manager of their El Segundo Refinery, informed him that the committee investigating Los Angeles "smog" had disclosed lead particles and also chlorinated hydrocarbons in some of their air sample analyses.
