I am sure that relationships with the provincial health

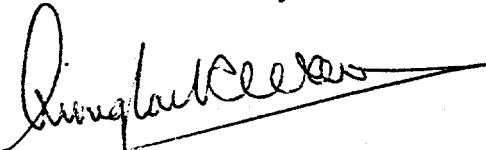
