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ACTION PLANS FOR PCB'S

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Attached is a statement of the decisions that have been made to cover Monsanto Industrial Chemicals Company plans with respect to future sales of PCB's and polychlorinated terphenyls.

Our Legal Department has approved the attached statement, and it is my understanding that you have also approved it. We are sending you several copies so that you may make any distribution of it you may deem necessary at the corporate level of the company.

At the present time we are working closely with the Legal Department to complete the final wording of the various notifications that will be going to our customers as we take actions to implement the decisions.

As a result of our complete study of the PCB situation, which was reviewed by Messrs. Sommer, Bock, Bible and Putzell on November 15, 1971, the following decisions have been taken:

1. Terminate immediately all sales of PCB fluids for use in heat transfer applications by formal notice to all customers. However, at the discretion of the President or his designee, if a customer's special circumstances prevent an immediate change to other materials, sales may be continued for the shortest possible period, provided that any such sales will be dependent upon the receipt of agreements acceptable to Monsanto, holding Monsanto harmless from legal liability associated with the use of PCB's in heat transfer applications from customers whose financial responsibility makes such agreements meaningful in Monsanto's opinion.
2. Sales of PCB fluids for transformer or capacitor use will be dependent upon the receipt of agreements acceptable to Monsanto, holding Monsanto harmless from legal liability associated with the use of PCB's in transformers and capacitors from customers whose financial responsibility makes such agreements meaningful in Monsanto's opinion.
3. Immediately implement a plan to terminate all sales of polychlorinated terphenyls:

MON-MT-008661

75% of such sales will be terminated by
March 31, 1972.

The remainder will be terminated no later
than June 30, 1972,

4. In addition to notices previously given and those
appearing on labels, all sales are to be accompanied
by an appropriate warning as to consequences of
improper use or disposition.

Action plans to implement these decisions are under way.

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
