Since the Department of Transportation first passed the Regulations governing the packaging, labeling and transportation of Hazardous Materials, the NAPA member companies have struggled in their attempts to develop compliance programs.

The NAPA Board of Directors has decided that in the years since the Regulations were first adopted, you as a possible supplier of these materials, have obtained the necessary expertise to assist our member NAPA companies in their compliance programs.

To this end we are asking that you complete the attached form as it would relate to each product you distribute through NAPA Distribution Centers and which would come within the definition of a Hazardous Material as defined in 49 CFR 172.101. In order to keep our files current, please instruct the appropriate people in your organization to forward to this office, any changes to their information that may occur in the future, and to send forms to us as new products are added that may fall within the definition of this regulation.
