METROPOLITAN NEW YORK APPRENTICE PLUMBER
WON TOP HONORS

Theodore McKenna, an apprentice in Plumbers Local Union 326, Hackensack, N.J., won top honors in plumbers lead work in competition with forty-two State and Canadian Province champions at the Third Annual International Apprentice Contest held at Purdue University, Lafayette, Ind.

The contest, of which lead work was one phase of the plumbing performance test, was sponsored by the United Association of Journeymen and Apprentices of the Plumbing and Pipe Fitting Industry.

Apprentice McKenna, in addition to the first place award in lead work, also received third place honors in the competition for the best all-around plumbing apprentice in the United States and Canada.
