Reliable reports said Auriole, seeking a swift end to the two-day-old political crisis, had decided to call on Socialist Jules Moch to try to form a new coalition government despite certain opposition.

But Rene Capitant, Gaullist National Assembly group leader, said after a conference with Auriole that a solution will be achieved "only when we turn to the electorate and ask the country for new mandates."

"We think that the present situation is not based on the simple question of salaries and prices," he said. "It is closely tied to the entire economic situation and to the great international problems."

General expectation was that Auriole would ask Moch, 56-year-old Minister of Interior to form a new government. Moch was the man primarily responsible for breaking the communist strike movements in 1947 and 1948.

Moch interrupted a vacation in Rome to fly back to Paris yesterday. He conferred at once with Premier Henri Queuille whose resignation Wednesday launched France into its 11th political crisis since 1944.

Although Moch generally was credited with wanting the premiership, political experts believed neither he nor any other Socialist stood much chance of forming a government at the moment.
