Field Trip

As of the previous day, Branson said, County Planning Director Ed DeMars had stated that further delay was necessary so that new members of the County Planning Commission may be fully conversant with the report. The commission will make a field trip to the valley for an on-the-site study, June 7.

Branson further commented that he had never seen a complete study of the residential capability of the valley.

In relation to sewage disposal, the supervisor reported that Hahn, Wise and Associates, and Neil Engineers have been authorized to apply for a No. 701 federal study grant for the valley, which, when completed, would be followed by a 702 grant which

Involved in the 701 study, he indicated, will also be flood control, water distribution, storm drainage and the like with Carmel Highlands also taken into consideration. An announcement on flood control, particularly at the mouth of the valley, will be made in from 10 days to two weeks, Branson added.

In discussing elimination of the "G" zone, which under certain acreage restrictions and use permits, allows resort hotels and clubs, hospitals, rest homes, executive office and research laboratories, Branson cited eight advantages which he could see in

Other questions invited from the floor developed into an exchange of views on present and future traffic hazards, smog prospects from an increased number of cars, and the suggestion that future smog is the best argument for enacting the slope density formula into an ordinance.

Tax Rate

Despite his "previous engagement," Branson remained to present a breakdown of the county tax rate, illustrated with charts.

Showing that the greatest cost increases to taxpayers have come in welfare and law enforcement, he emphasized the fact that the county rate has remained constant since 1959, but conceded that increases in assessed valuation have had the same effect as higher taxes.
