

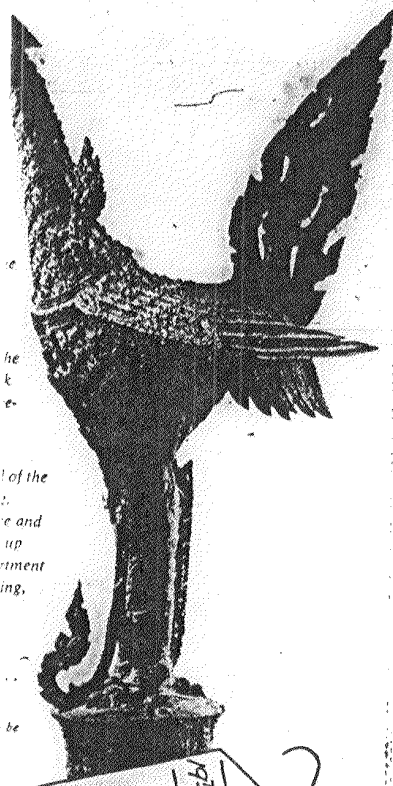

## Polish Cardinal Speaks Out

—WARSAW, Poland, April  
2 (AP) — Stefan Cardinal  
Wyszynski, primate of Po-  
land, assured Polish Ro-  
man Catholics in an Easter  
message today that all at-  
tempts to "close the lips  
of the church are in vain  
because we must obey God  
rather than men."

The Cardinal spoke after  
celebrating Easter high mass  
before nearly 1000 persons in  
Warsaw's Cathedral of St.  
John.

Using veiled terms that  
contrasted sharply with his  
charges two weeks ago that  
the church in Poland is being  
persecuted, the Cardinal said:

"So often seals have been  
laid on the mouth of the  
church so it would be silent.  
So often it has been bur-  
dened with stones. So often  
so many false witnesses have  
come forth. But all that was  
in vain because Christ lives  
in the church and, once hav-  
ing died, will not die again."

## Polaris Sub Sails--Spies Signalling?

GLASGOW, Scotland.  
April 2 (UPI) — Soviet  
trawlers off the coast of  
Scotland apparently work-  
ing by radio with spies on  
shore are trying to track  
the United States missile-  
carrying submarine oper-  
ating out of the Holy Loch,  
it was reported today.

Authoritative sources said  
Western intelligence agents  
were swarming through the  
area seeking land-based spies  
believed in radio contact with  
the trawlers just outside ter-  
ritorial waters.

Disclosure of the spy op-  
erations came 24 hours after  
the Polaris-carrying subma-  
rine Patrick Henry sailed  
from the American base at  
nearby Holy Loch on the first  
underwater nuclear mission  
ever sent out from an over-  
seas base.

Movements of the Patrick  
Henry were curtailed in si-  
lence and the only word  
made public was that it was  
on a cold water patrol some-  
where in the direction of the  
Arctic.

Investigators disclosed they  
had picked up radio signals  
reaching the trawlers be-  
lieved sent from points on  
the west coast of Scotland,  
probably in and around the  
Glasgow area.
