

Fast Time in Speedway Trials

Jimmy Murphy Sets New Record at Fresno

FRESNO, April 24.—Jimmy Murphy, holder of the world's speed championship crown, added new laurels today to his record when he piloted his Durant special racing car over the speedway oval in the elimination trials in 32 seconds, an average of 112 1/4 miles an hour, a record for the track.

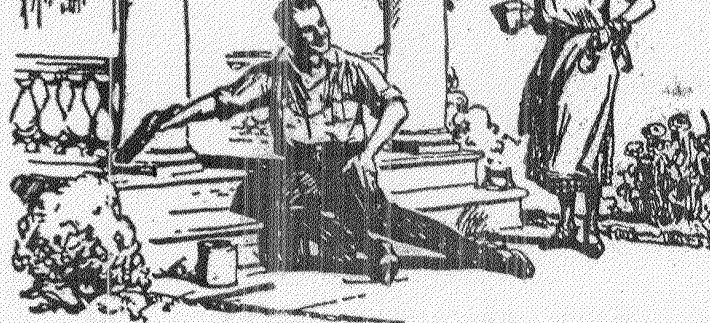
Murphy followed Ralph Hepburn, famous motorcycle star, who is to make his debut as an automobile racing driver on Thursday, when he will pilot Tommy Milton's 182-inch car in the Raisin day contest. Hepburn made the oval in 34 seconds and qualified.

Others to qualify and the time they made follow: Peter Depalao, 34 seconds; Bennie Hill, 32.2 seconds; Frank Elliott, 34 seconds; Harry Hart, 32.4 seconds; Earl Cooper, 32 seconds; Joe Thomas, 34 seconds; Duray, 33.1 seconds; Eddie Hearne, 34 seconds; Cliff Durant, 32.4 seconds.

Al Melcher, who made the trials in 34.1 seconds; Morton, 35 seconds, and Tommy Milton, who tried out his little 142-cubic inch job, will make their final trials tomorrow, and the one making the best time will be allowed in the race, the other two being eliminated, as the contest board of the American Automobile Association will allow but twelve cars to race on the track.

U. S. Consul Dies at Strasbourg, France

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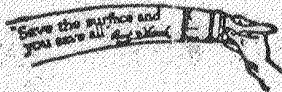
