Listed below are some of the questions that the Louisville Plant feels its employees may ask in regards to the present Osha standards.

1. If cannisters and respirator replacements are not available or supplies are out, can a man refuse or be required to work in a regulated area?
2. At what level of VCL can a man act on his own to vacate an area?
3. If an area gets above 25 ppm and no air line respirators are available, what do we do?
4. If a man is exposed to 50 ppm and above, is there any data to show that the effects of it is harmful to his health on a long term basis?
5. Are the present medical tests adequate enough to determine and prevent angiosarcoma or is there additional work being done to develop new tests?
6. Are the tests that were performed on test animals relative to humans?
7. What effects are the present test having on the human body using radio-isotopes annually to scan the liver?
8. If a man retires or quits from B.F. Goodrich and later develops angiosarcoma, what are B.F. Goodrich's responsibilities to that individual?
9. Are there any additional materials used by B.F. Goodrich that are suspected of being Carcinogenic in nature?
10. If there are, what does B.F. Goodrich intend to do about them?
