Dear Sam:

Some few weeks ago you reported to us the procedure that was carried out in making deliveries of MTHL fluid to the mixing points in your division. This was referred to Dr. Kehoe and we now have his comments on same. He thinks that the recommendations made in your letter should be put into effect and that you should personally arrange for shipments of MTHL fluid in a manner that you know will be entirely safe. He thinks that the oil companies must stand any expenses necessary to accomplish this rather than for us to permit them to choose any means of shipment which happens to be convenient or slightly more economical.

We would thank you to please take this up with the respective companies and see that arrangements are made for the handling of fluid on such a basis in the future.
