Dear Jim:

This will acknowledge receipt of your order 01-33604 covering the 10 special patterns of Asbestos MICAFTA required for the Moore-McCormack passenger and cargo vessels. On October 28, 1957 Mr. Demant called and gave us the following changes on this order:

These changes have been made on the order here at Hampton.

Mr. Demant also advised that the size involved on the .050 Asbestos MICAFTA will be 48 x 96. Our purchase orders for the print paper have been entered on the basis of 48" width only, and therefore we take exception to the listing of sizes given on page 1 of order 01-33604.

We also must take exception to the following notes on the order 01-33604:

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1. We cannot guarantee a sheet with a minimum 1" overage on width and 1 1/2" on length. We will trim with as much overage as possible, but



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can only guarantee that the length and width shall be such that a rectangle of the size specified (88 x 96) can be obtained. (NEMA LP2-1.04)

2. This note should be changed to read: Sheets shall be equal to .050 Asbestos, MICARTA sheets previously supplied.

3. Add - "when formed according to manufacturers recommendations."

4. Change to read: Finished laminated sheets to have a gloss meter reading of 20 or less on a Gardner Glass Meter calibrated with a black standard at 82.

5. We cannot guarantee anything other than specified in #1 above, however, we will trim in width as even as possible in relation to pattern.

6. Delete "except as might be directed by the buyer." All markings on face of sheet will be eliminated unless cost of special markings is negotiated.

7. Accepted

8. Grade Number, not color, will be shown.

9. Change to read: All materials furnished on this order shall meet, where applicable, the standard of quality as set forth in NEMA Standard May, 1957.

10. Accepted. Please include this note on ALL releases.

11. Delete and refer to Decorative MICARTA Selling Policy 66-000. We will ship in full through truck lots when possible but cannot agree to clause "or as directed by us".

Will you please have a change notice entered incorporating the above changes.

With reference to your letter of October 24 relative to 01-33604, will you enter your formal cancellation of 01-33492.

Mr. Dement has notified Decotone relative to the change in item 1. Acceptance of the printing on this pattern, H-4288, will be the responsibility of U. S. Plywood or Raymond Lowey.
