Leaded Zinc Oxide - Ozlo 1288

This will confirm our recent phone conversation at which time I indicated that Sherwin-Williams paint plants have already placed on Coffeyville enough orders to keep the Leaded Zinc plant in full production until August 31st. It is absolutely necessary that we terminate production of this material by the end of this fiscal year and I, therefore, ask you to advise all of the Sherwin-Williams plant purchasing people that, effective immediately, no additional Leaded Zinc Oxide orders should be placed on the Coffeyville plant.

Certainly, with the extended time that we have given the paint plants, they should have completed the transition from the Ozlo Leaded Zinc to the Oxide 30P and we are very much looking forward to supplying the plant requirements with this new material.
