Alison,

Please attribute to an agency spokesperson:

The active ingredients you have listed meet EPA criteria to be used in DfE-labeled disinfectant or antimicrobial products. This means that they are safer for people, pets, and the environment. To meet the criteria, all the ingredients in the product must be of low-concern for human health endpoints, such as cancer, reproductive and developmental effects, and must also be of low toxicity for the environment. They must biodegrade quickly to products of low concern. EPA only evaluates products that apply to bear the DfE or Safer Choice label.

EPA does not require products to display the Safer Choice logo, although most manufacturers put the Safer Choice label on products certified to carry it.

Most Clorox Green Works products meet Safer-Choice criteria and are listed on EPA's Safer-Choice web site.

Clorox manufactures its Green Works products for consumer and institutional markets. Green Works product sold into the institutional market – for use in hotels and schools, for example – carry the Safer Choice label.

On background: We suggest you ask Clorox directly about their plans for using the Safer Choice logo on their consumer products. The best contacts for you are:

Hi Alison and Cecily, I totally see where you are coming from. Especially since not all anti-microbial products approved by DfE even use that logo on their packaging. I'm not sure there's a clear cut guidance here but I'll ask. Essentially, it sounds like you are trying to create a sentence along these lines: "For anti-microbial products on the greener end of the spectrum, look for ingredients such as \_\_\_\_\_, \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_. Hi Christie,

I hope you're doing well! Thank you again for all of your amazing help the other week. I got more edits back from my editor, Cecily, who's cc'd here, and she's looking for a bit more clarification on the antimicrobials we discussed. Specifically, she's concerned (understandably) that if we encourage readers to look for EPA-labeled antimicrobial

products, that they'll mistakenly think to look for Safer Choice-labeled products, as we won't be getting into all of the DfE/FIFRA nitty-gritty that you and I discussed.

So, with that in mind, we're wondering if it's accurate to tell readers to look for "sanitizers with TK or TK as their active ingredients," those TKs being two of the active ingredients approved for use in products for the DfE pesticide pilot? For the TKs, we were thinking maybe hydrogen peroxide and citric acid, but wanted your take on which of the active ingredients appeared most often in EPA-labeled products.

I know that's a lot of questions and info, so please let me know if I can clarify any of that request.

Okay, this is off the record:

Sanitizers are antimicrobial, so they fall under the category of

pesticides. Under FIFRA – The Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act – aka the federal pesticide act – EPA can't use comparative safety labels such as "Safer Choice" for pesticides.

We use the same Safer Choice process and the same criteria with sanitizers, but we have to use the DfE label on their packaging.
