Dear Dr. Wright,

Our finance committee has just received word from the Trustees of the Commonwealth Fund that the time we have in which to match their proposed donation of \$5,000 a year for the next five years has now been limited to December 18, 1929. You perhaps recall that in our previous conversation I had supposed that we had an unlimited time in which to raise this sum. I am particularly anxious that if possible this laboratory should establish official connections with the Metropolitan, for reasons which you can well understand. Do you suppose that there is any chance of our getting action on the question in the near future? If not, I will of necessity have to look elsewhere for financial support, because their proposal is too good to turn down. Please do not believe that I am trying to press the matter unduly, but the letter from the Commonwealth Fund naturally worries me somewhat.
