So sorry to have failed to make contact when you were in the Bay Area recently. Tried to contact you through Johnny Edgar at Martinez also.

Professor Moyer is most anxious to secure current data on the subject "The Contribution of Motor Vehicle Exhaust Gases to Urban Air Pollution". No doubt you remember our touching on this question during luncheon at the Faculty Club on 2-15-50. I believe you said that certain research was going on in the Los Angeles area or Detroit. May we be advised of the extent and results to date, and would you suggest our directing an inquiry to Mr. E. C. Paige at Detroit. In view of the 100% General Motors line adoption of front-end ventilating air intake location, perhaps he may know of a similar General Motors Research project.

Specifically, please outline work done to date or in progress by Ethyl Corporation, or who is equipped to make measurements of the minute content of injurious and/or irritating gases or airborne products; -- what work has been done to date on motor vehicle engines with respect to control of their products of combustion?

Thank you for your consideration of the above, and I hope to see you, Gil, when next you visit this area.
