Second Prize Award-Made Salad Contest

The second prize in the Salad Review sponsored by Martha Lee at her last Tuesday meeting was awarded to the entry of Mrs. Clara Holman, a former director of the Oakland Women's City Club, for and on behalf of that club.

It was a vegetable wheel, the rim of which was a tomato aspic and each of the six sections of the wheel was a different vegetable within the aspic ring. This was placed in the middle of a large platter around which attractively arranged were slices of cold meats and cheese together with pickles and olives. While the salad was not named, it might well be called "Wagon Wheels."

The third prize was the

WATER LILY SALAD

Cut 4 grapefruit around in notches, cutting through to center; separate, remove pulp and juice.

To one cup of the juice add 2 envelopes (2 tablespoons) of gelatin, soak 5 minutes.

Heat one cup of pulp and juice. When hot dissolve the gelatin in it. Combine with 2 cups of fruit, using the grapefruit and adding pineapple, or any other fruit desired such as strawberries in season, peaches, etc. Have 4 cups altogether.

Pour into cups, or sherbet glasses, ringed with cold water. When ready to serve, place sliced bananas or any desired fruit in grapefruit baskets, add a little Fruit Salad Dressing Supreme, unmold the salad on top with strips of avocado and Fruit Salad Dressing Supreme and top with maraschino cherries. Makes 8 servings.

Fruit Salad Dressing Supreme

- 2 eggs, or 4 yolks
- 4 tablespoons vinegar
- 4 tablespoons sugar
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon dry mustard

Place the above ingredients in top of double boiler; cook over boiling water, beating with Dover beater, a few minutes until thoroughly mixed. Remove from fire and add 10 marshmallows. Beat with spoon until marshmallows are dissolved. Cool. When ready to use add equal quantity of whipped cream.

The cans, which are opened with a key, are so made because of their advantage in taking on motor trips (which we here in California are so prone to do over the week-end) for sandwiches made on the spot. They retail for a dime or less, and you will find them a most satisfying product to use in meat loaves, sandwiches, salads, or any place where chopped ripe olives are needed.
