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The HPCA has petitioned the FDA to adopt a proposed amendment to the FDA order limiting lead in paints used in and around the household. The proposed amendment will be published in the Federal Register by about November 10 for public comment.

The amendment, if adopted, will exempt automotive, industrial, and agricultural refinish paints, industrial maintenance coatings, touch-up coatings, exterior marine coatings, and redwood and cedar exterior primer coatings.

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
