RE: Blood Lead Comparison Program

LIA is now requesting from all member companies, distinguished by results for the fourth quarter (October 1 to December 31) of 1982. We encourage all member companies of LIA to participate in this program. Also, for those companies who are already involved in the program, this will be more valuable and effective if companies provide data on a quarterly basis.

No extra effort should be made to establish a new program. The program should be maintained. The request for data is being made on a quarterly basis. The data is available on request to OSHA and is used for the purpose of the program. The time required to translate the data is approximately 10-15 minutes. We prefer that companies enter the data on a quarterly basis. If this is not feasible, a form for the data is enclosed. Companies who are unable to provide data on a quarterly basis are requested to provide a summary of results for the quarter. This should be submitted with the following information: name, address, telephone, and personnel by department.

Please keep employees informed of the program from quarter to quarter so that at a later date it will be possible to identify trends in individual trends. We are not interested in the overall number, and in fact would prefer to have a code for each company. If you could identify which industry your company is in, please bring to (i.e. Primary, Secondary, Battery, Chemical, etc. or other).
