Perhaps you could help me with a problem or refer this letter to someone who could. I had a litter of Great Dane pups that the Vet said was showing clinical signs of lead poisoning. The Vet attempted to locate the source of the problem. The only thing the Vet and I even suspect at this point was a new bag of "Thrivetts" dog food which the litter had been recently introduced to. Delare Labs analyzed the dog food and found it to have a lead content of 0.4 ppm. The Vet or I have been unable to locate any information on the acceptable amount of lead in feedstuffs. We would appreciate any information you might have on this subject or any suggestions as to where to find the information.
