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TML--Japan

Dr. Akatsuka points out that Japan has a TEL regulation which will have to be amended to include TML. Therefore, in accordance with Dr. Kehoe's letter of June 4 the approach will be made by hygienic authorities to get government approval to use TML in Japan.

After considerable discussion in Japan it was decided that Dr. Akatsuka would present the TML reports of Dr. Kehoe to the Japanese Ministries of Labor and Public Health and Welfare. Dr. Akatsuka will supplement Dr. Kehoe's reports with some TML data of his own based on tests in his laboratory at the Tokyo Medical College. Prior to presentation to the Ministries, Dr. Akatsuka will hold discussions with other eminent authorities who are his colleagues on the committees for Labor and Public Health. It is felt that this procedure will secure approval and is better than an approach by Ethyl or the refining industry.

By copy of this letter I am requesting Dr. Kehoe to supply necessary TML information to Dr. Akatsuka for his use with the Japanese authorities.

Dr. Kehoe's letter of June 4 was most helpful in deciding the proper approach to this matter.
