PLISULATE

(Statement)

Plisulco Jointless Firebrick Company, a corporation duly organized under the laws of the State of Illinois, located at Chicago, Illinois, and doing business at 1800 Kingsbury Street, Chicago 14, Illinois, has adopted and is using the trade-mark shown in the accompanying drawing, for PLASTIC AND NON-PLASTIC HEAT INSULATING MATERIAL, COMPRISING INSULATING CEMENT; INSULATING BLOCK COMPRISING MINERAL WOOL, ASBESTOS FIBRE, AND COLLOIDAL CLAY; INSULATING FELT; INSULATING BLANKETS; AND INSULATING WOOL, in Class 12, Construction materials, and present herewith five (5) facsimiles showing the trade-mark as actually used in connection with such goods, the trade-mark being applied to the containers for the goods, and requests that the same be registered in the United States Patent Office on the Principal Register in accordance with the act of July 5, 1948.

The trade-mark was first used on plastic heat insulating material on July 14, 1939, and was first used on plastic heat insulating material in commerce among the several States which may lawfully be regulated by Congress on July 14, 1939. The trade-mark was first used on non-plastic heat insulating material

1939, and was first used on non-plastic heat insulating material in commerce among the several States which may lawfully be regulated by Congress in September, 1939.

Applicant is the owner of Trade-Mark Registration No. 385,659, registered March 14, 1939.
