Dear Sir:

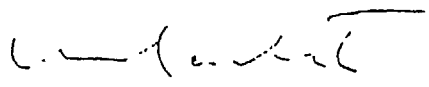
I have examined Mr. Fred Turco on July 1, 1976 and found him to be suffering from chronic obstructive pulmonary disease. From his history, it appears that he had been working with asbestos some 30 or 40 years ago and again for some period 3 or 4 years ago. In addition, Mr. Turco states that he is at present working in an atmosphere laden with stone dust.

Mr. Turco's chest X-Rays show a definite progression of diffuse interstitial thickening of both lung bases since 1969. On his latest X-Ray of three weeks ago, this has now progressed to a fine nodularity, indicating encroachment on the alveolar spaces.

★ I have advised Mr. Turco that these changes are most suggestive of asbestosis, considering his occupational contact with asbestos. In addition, I have advised him to avoid further exposure to silica dust forth-with.

I would strongly recommend that arrangements be made which would keep Mr. Turco away from that part of the shop where he would have dust exposure.
