#### Sunday 3 September 2017

#### **Via Commercial Flights – not viable on a Sunday as flights are limited**

Departing Sydney at 2.05pm arriving 2.50pm into Newcastle (Rex 376)

Departing Sydney at 3.05pm arriving 3.50pm into Newcastle (Pelican 217)

Departing Newcastle at 5.00pm arriving 5.45pm into Sydney (Rex 377)

#### **Via road transport**

Approximately 2.5 – 3 hours each way (220 kms)

#### **Via Charter flights – options currently being investigated**

Helicopter out of Sydney Airport direct to Wambo Site

Light aircraft out of Sydney Airport to Cessnock / drive to site approx. 40 minutes

#### **Site Visit**

Approximately 2 hours with short presentation, pit tour and visit to rehabilitation area

#### **Option 1: Suggested Itinerary (assumes Saturday night accommodation in Sydney)**

**Option 2:** As per above, but arrive site earlier, refreshments on arrival and late lunch at local Hunter Valley Vineyard before heading to Newcastle Airport.

**Option 3:** Pending charter flight availability, fly into Cessnock, drive to site, site visit as per above with adjusted timings, lunch at local Hunter Valley Vineyard, fly out of Cessnock.
