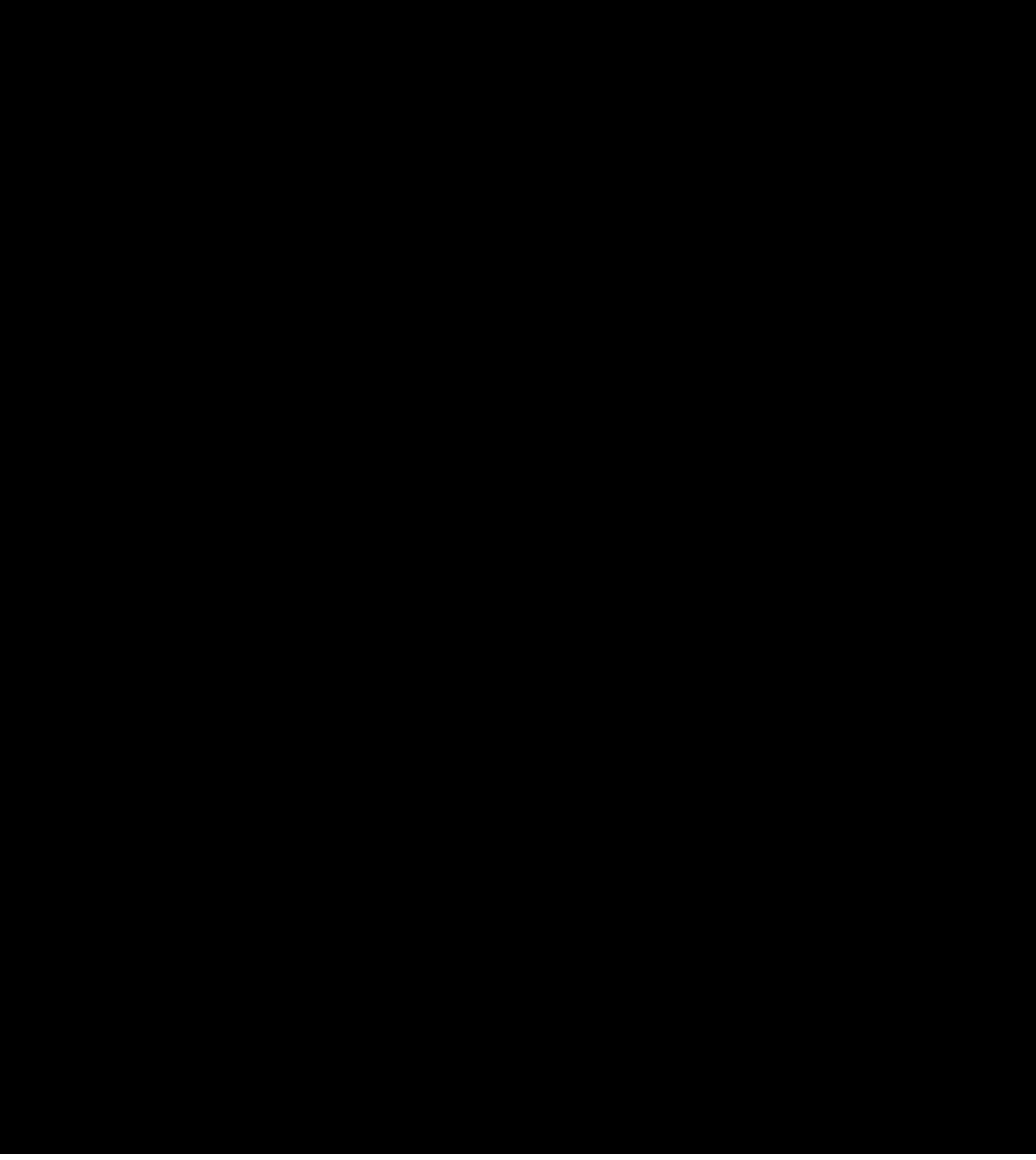

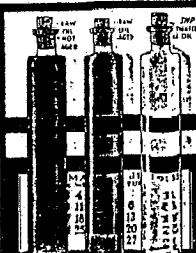

Separating weed seeds from the flaxseed, filtering the oil, removing the mucilaginous matter and aging in storage tanks are but a few of the many processes carried out with scrupulous care by Sherwin-Williams before the oil may be used in SWP. ECONOMY OF USE

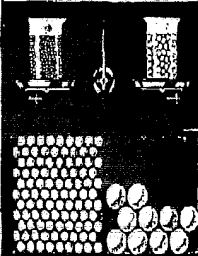

ECONOMY OF APPLICATION

It is easily possible to save 10% on labor cost of painting a house by using SWP. The paint hides the surface so completely and it takes so much less effort in making the paint look well — without laps or cloudy spots — that the painter can cover more surface in a day with SWP than with any other paint. The paint that saves on labor cost actually costs you less, no matter what the cost by the gallon may be.



FINE GRINDING



How can a gallon of SWP cover so much more surface than another paint which may weigh just as much and be made on a good formula? Here is a picture of two boxes, each containing the same amount of shot but with one batch considerably smaller than the other. Observe how much more surface the small size shot cover. The same principle applies to SWP as compared to paints not ground as finely — SWP always covers more.

Simple addition —
Pigments (made by Sherwin-Williams)
Lined Oil (made by Sherwin-Williams)
Colors (made by Sherwin-Williams)
Fine grinding (in Sherwin-Williams)
Sum Totals The Ideal House Paint
Covering — Spreading — Working
The total is the sum of all parts — take away any part and total must be less.

360 square feet 2 coats per gallon is a modest claim for SWP, but we need make no exaggerated claims for our products. The important consideration is the beautiful, solid-hiding finish obtained with SWP. The same lack of fine grinding and use of inferior ingredients that limits the covering power of ordinary paints also impairs their durability and appearance. SWP always covers more and — beautifully.

CLOSER KNIT FILM

With SWP the painter finds it much easier to hide an old, discolored surface. This is because its extremely fine ground pigments make a closer knit film of greater opacity. Each particle is also better protected with its film of linseed oil than is possible when the paint is not ground to this same fineness. It costs more to make SWP but its closer knit film doubles its protective value.

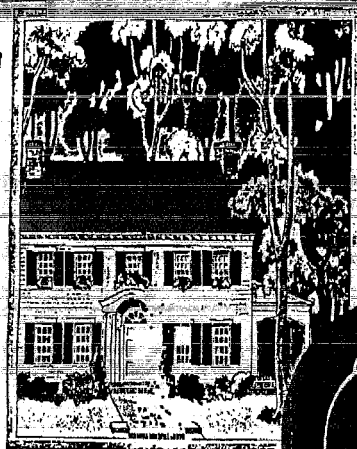

Beauty of Finish

When you examine the surface of a house painted with SWP the conspicuous thing you notice is the beauty of the finish. Opacity of Paint Film

The reasons for the ability of SWP to cover an old, discolored surface with so solid and opaque a finish are shown in an interesting way on the other side of this color card. Be sure to read it.

Self-Cleansing

Different kinds of house paint show considerable variation in their ability to shed the dirt. Some paints "chalk" excessively and become very badly

streaked by the weather. Others seem to simply attract the dirt and become grimy and dingy, even though they may be actually providing good protection against decay.

The reasons why SWP Gloss White retains its gleaming whiteness after ordinary white paints have taken on a grayish cast are as follows:

1. The pigments, as we combine them in SWP, are not subject to discoloration by the conditions ordinarily found in the atmosphere.
