SUBJECT: Special Report on Phase IV

Dues paid to nonprofit organizations are exempt. Cost of Living Council says economic controls will not apply to dues payments after current freeze phase ends. Effective date is August 12. Until that time, Phase III freeze continues. No exceptions.

All economic controls will end for smaller associations. Acting on request by ASAE, Cost of Living Council says nonprofit organizations with 60 or fewer employees will be excluded from economic controls after August 12. That means freedom from all wage and price controls. Situation, really, will be the same as it was under Phase II controls. Exemption for nonprofits is the same as for small business firms.
