2 And so, as I recall, some of the methods
3 finally ended up in our report, with some of the
4 methods Ford talked about as well.

5 Q So you don't take issue with any of the
6 methods that were adopted in the '73 bulletin, do
7 you?

8 A Well, I can't say that I have gone back
9 through and reviewed it again. We certainly looked at
10 that Ford document.

11 We updated where we thought were appropriate
12 in our interim recommendations.

13 Q Without the benefit of hindsight, just
14 focusing on what happened actually in the mid '70s,
15 the control methods that were adopted in the Ford
16 bulletin, you were in favor of those, weren't you?

17 A Well, certainly those methods, any time you
18 can get away from using compressed air to blow out the
19 assembly, you are going to reduce dust exposures.
