Dear Mr. Stokes:

The company indicated, at the meeting held on January 7, 1972 at the East Texas Chest Hospital, that we would pay for the employee consultations that may be necessary after Dr. Hurst had completed the physical reports on all those employees examined by him. This has been accomplished. Furthermore, we also indicated that we would pay for any follow-up examinations that may be necessary for any of the employees in the future; these would be scheduled by Dr. Hurst.

This is the extent of what we had intended to pay for outside of any Workmen's Compensation Claim a person may file if they feel they have an occupationally oriented illness. Necessary medical expenses would be paid for under the compensation claim.

In regard to the medical examination for the employees, they are currently being prepared for mailing to the employees and should be forthcoming shortly.
