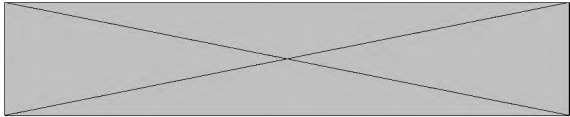

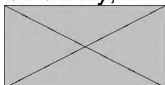

That fact should be the foundation of our national energy conversation, and I look forward to advocating for policies that will ensure American families and businesses have the reliable, affordable, energy they need.

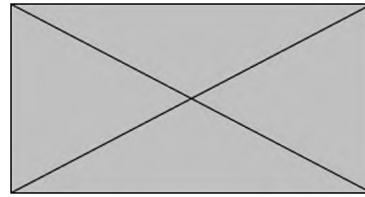

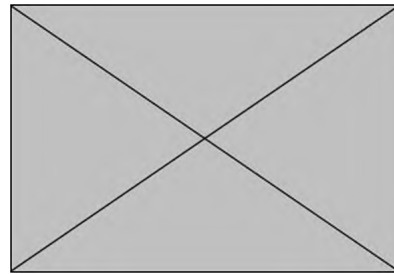
U.S. Oil, Increased Access Can Boost Global Supply
