In compliance with your request of this morning, I am enclosing a statement written by Dr. J. A. Green, Jr., who was one of the attending physicians while [REDACTED] was in our hospital. Barring all unforeseen complications, of course, the enclosed statement holds good.

Although [REDACTED] was admitted into our hospital on September 25, 1939, it was several weeks before a diagnosis was made, and on October 17th an exploratory operation was performed; the appendix was removed. On or about December 1, 1939 Harper should be able to return to his job.

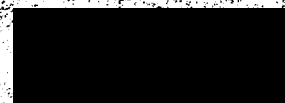
