Dear Mr. Kickel,

This letter is written in response to your recent letters of November 6 and November 19, 1986, as well as several telephone conversations with Mr. Tom Sheikh and yourself concerning Carlisle's commitment to satisfy Eaton's asbestos lining block requirements through January 1, 1988.

On November 19, 1986, you were advised that Mr. Sheikh was notified on November 14, 1986, that our original projected asbestos volumes, which were submitted on October 14, 1986, be revised as follows:

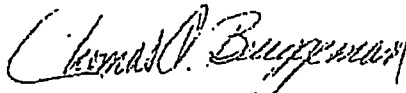
