I am sending you some correspondence concerning requests for information made by Professor G. Fred Lee of the University of Wisconsin. You will notice that E. P. Wheeler answered Prof. Lee's letter of September 29 on October 13. Prof. Lee wrote back on October 22 requesting some information that we cannot provide. Since Lee's letter he has printed a brief report covering PCB's in the Milwaukee River and has given us a copy of a data summary that he and his co-workers intend to publish later on. The Milwaukee River report and the data summary were given to Mr. Joe Metcalf of the Inorganic Division Staff by Prof. Lee directly.
