Confirming our phone conversation, I recommend that the asbestos inventory at Berlin be written down by 25% before the end of the year. This is to compensate for an anticipated discount on the selling price of the M grade, as a substitute fiber which will very likely be used in place of a lower cost grade.

In addition, it is likely that we will have to absorb some inland freight to make a sale.

For the benefit of others covered by this memo, it still appears likely that North American Asbestos Corporation will be able to sell this material for us during 1973. It is, however, uncertain as to whether the sale will be made early or late in the year. Any new information on the timing of the sale will be transmitted to all interested parties as soon as possible.
