6 A I think --

7 Q Do you understand the question?

8 A I think that a lot of times I would go back
9 to what I had said a few moments ago about the fact
10 that patients, when they give you an answer, they are
11 under a lot of stress and they may not be thinking
12 properly at a particular moment.

13 They may be tired and they may be in pain
14 and they may be medicated, and as a consequence, one
15 has to look at the information that one gets
16 subsequently.

17 I would give you two examples of how this
18 might apply to Mr. Wood.

19 The first has to do with the asbestos and
20 the apparent contradictions in what may have been his
21 degree of exposure.
