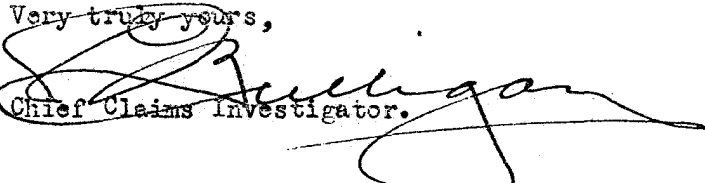
The above named decedent, who was
