Mr. Douglas V. Mumm completed a physical examination in this office for Vinyl Chloride Monomer Clearance May 2, 1977. He has no history of jaundice, no hepatitis or mononucleosis. He has had no exposure to vinyl chloride or vinyl chloride monomer. He did have some exposure (potential) to chlorine, with no irritant effect. There has been minimal lead exposure in the past but no cadmium or mercury exposure.

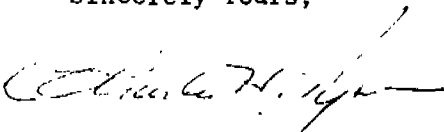

Detailed examination was entirely within normal limits. The liver edge was no palpable. There was no splenomegaly.
