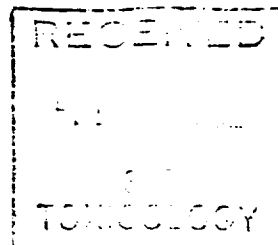

A white powdered solid labeled FC-143 Lot 37 (F-6052 Lot 94) (T-3141 COC) was received originally on October 28 and December 3, 1980 for characterization and analysis. This material was analyzed and used in several studies including the two year feeding study (T-G998COC) Riker Study #0281CR0012. The sample was re-analyzed for post 0681 TB0398 study with sample received from D. Ricker 29 Jan. 82. Sample was 100% solids.

Spectroscopic

Infrared spectra #16474-1 and 17958-1 are identical and match reference spectra.

NMR spectra H 8386, F 8388-9 (Pre) and F 10163-4 (Post) are identical and match reference spectra. The chain is 79% straight chain, 9% $(CF_3)_2CF$ - branching and 12% back bone branched.

Conclusions

FC-143 Lot 37 has an analysis within specifications, is stable and is representative of commercial material.
