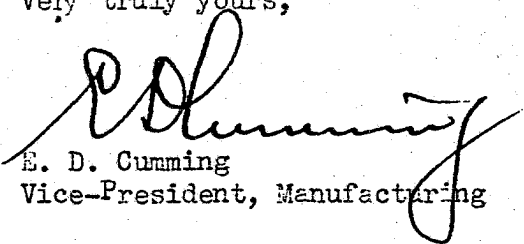
Dear Dr. Kehoe: ALLEGED LEAD POISONING AT WOOD RIVER REFINERY

We are happy to inform you that the [REDACTED] case, in which he claimed to have been poisoned by lead while working at his regular duties in the Treating Department of our Wood River Refinery, has been settled.

You will be interested to learn that in closing the books on this case we paid Mr. [REDACTED] the sum of \$250.00 as a "nuisance" settlement, but made no admission that he had been injured by lead poisoning while at work or that we were liable in any way for his illness.

We greatly appreciate and thank you for your advice and laboratory work, which undoubtedly was the deciding factor in clarifying the issues in the minds of all concerned, thereby making possible this very satisfactory settlement of the case.
